## 日本の伝統色 Japanese traditional color

雪色  
【SESSYOKU】

雪を連想させる純白の色。しかし、ただの白ではなく微妙な青みがかかった、透明感のある白さが特徴。古くから日本に存在する色の一つで、平安時代にはすでに貴族たちの衣装にこの色が用いられていたとされてる。日本画や浮世絵などの伝統芸術においても、冬に降り積もる雪の白さを表現する際にこの色が使われてきた。

A pure white color reminiscent of snow. However, it is not just white; it is characterized by a transparent white with a slight bluish. It is one of the colors that has existed in Japan since ancient times, and it is said that this color was already used in the costumes of aristocrats during the Heian period. This color has also been used in traditional art such as Japanese paintings and ukiyo-e to express the whiteness of snow that falls and piles up in winter.
