





鶯色【UGUISU-IRO】



鶯色とは、ウグイスの羽のような暗くすんだ黄緑色をさす。鶯色と聞くとやわらかな黄緑色を連想するかもしれないが、これはウグイスと、同じく春先によく見られるメジロの羽の色との混同が元となったと言われている。どこからか「ホーホケキョ」と声はするけれど、警戒心が強く人の前に姿を表さないウグイス。その美しいさえずりを春に聴かせてくれることから「春告げ鳥」とも呼ばれている。

Uguisu-iro is a dark dull yellow-green color, such as the wings of Japanese nightingale. It is usually imagined a soft yellow-green shade. However, it is said that this misconception originates from confusion with the plumage color of the Japanese white-eye (mejiro), a bird commonly seen in early spring, just like the Japanese nightingale (uguisu). Although you can hear its "hoh-hokekyo" chirping somewhere, they are highly cautious and rarely shows itself in front of people. It is also called the "spring bird" because of its beautiful chirping that can be heard in spring.
